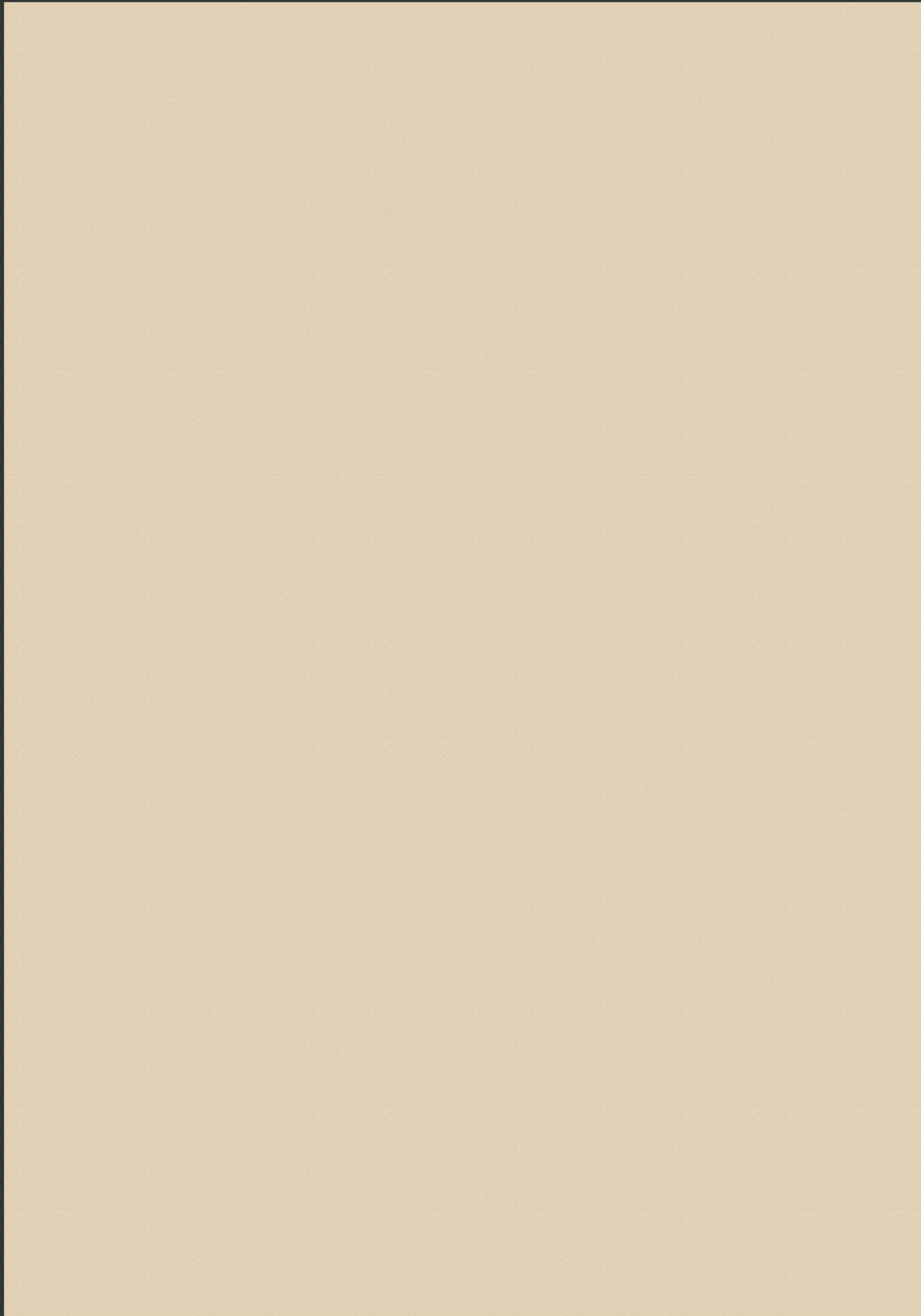


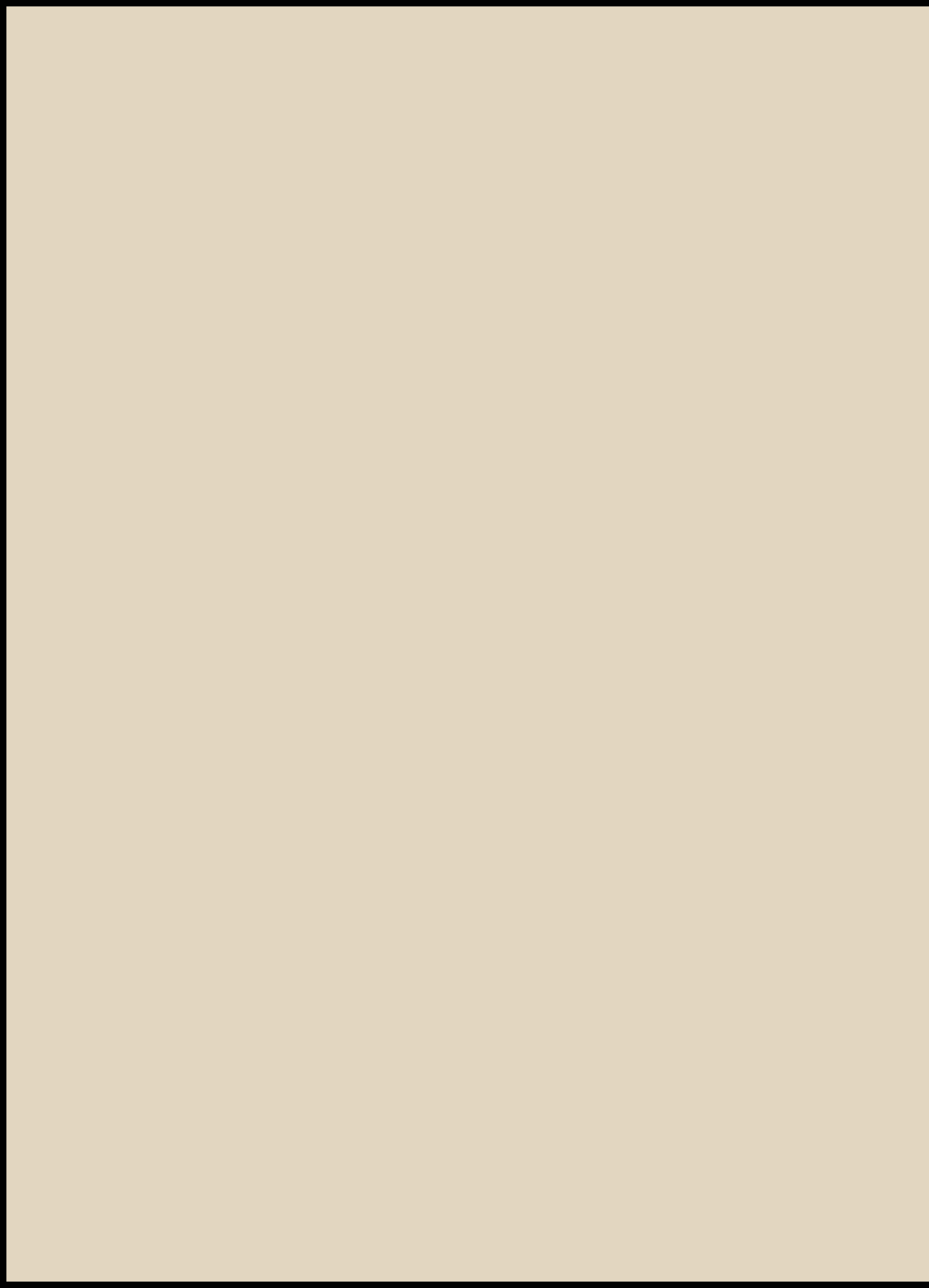

The person attending the reunion from the furthest distance was Glendine Crider, who attended from Corpus Christi.


