


Dear Students:

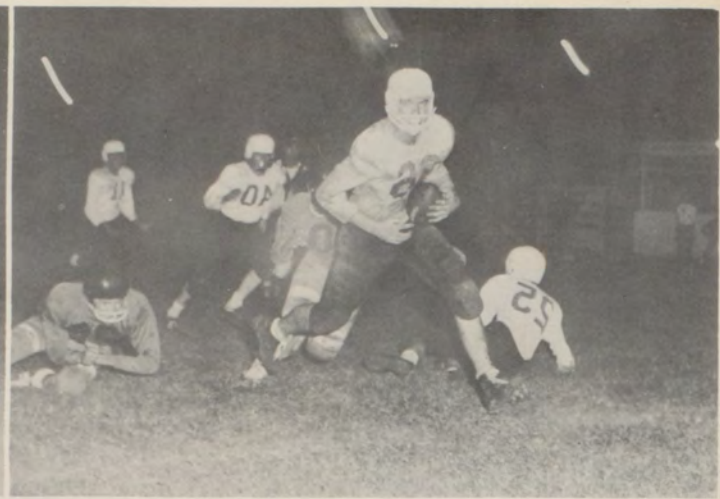

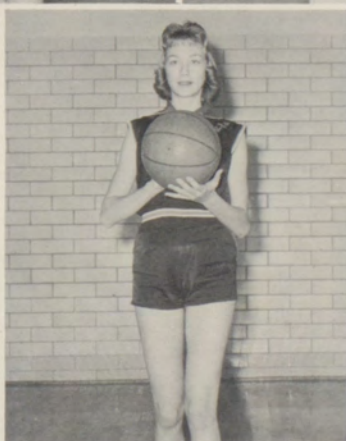
