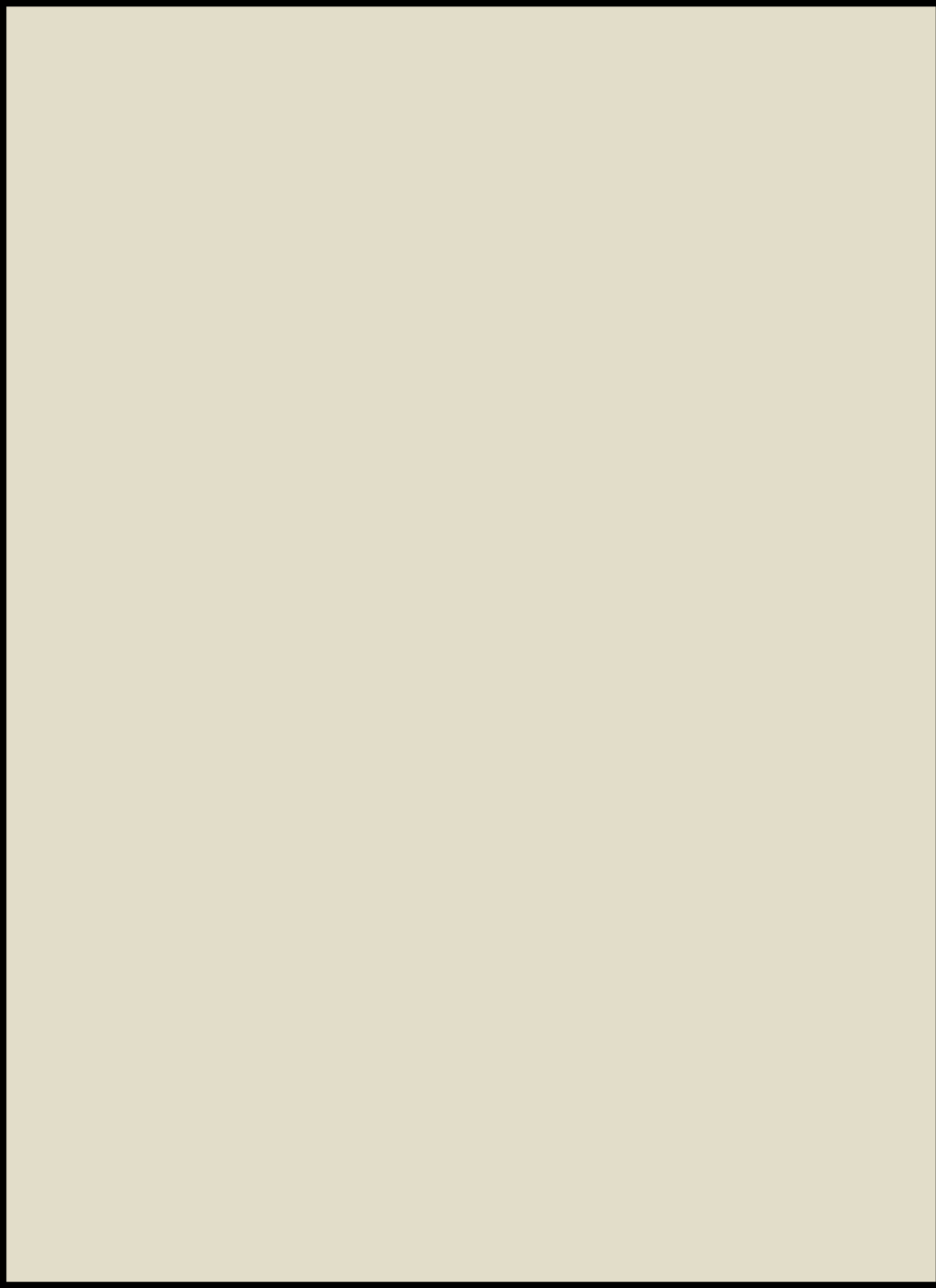


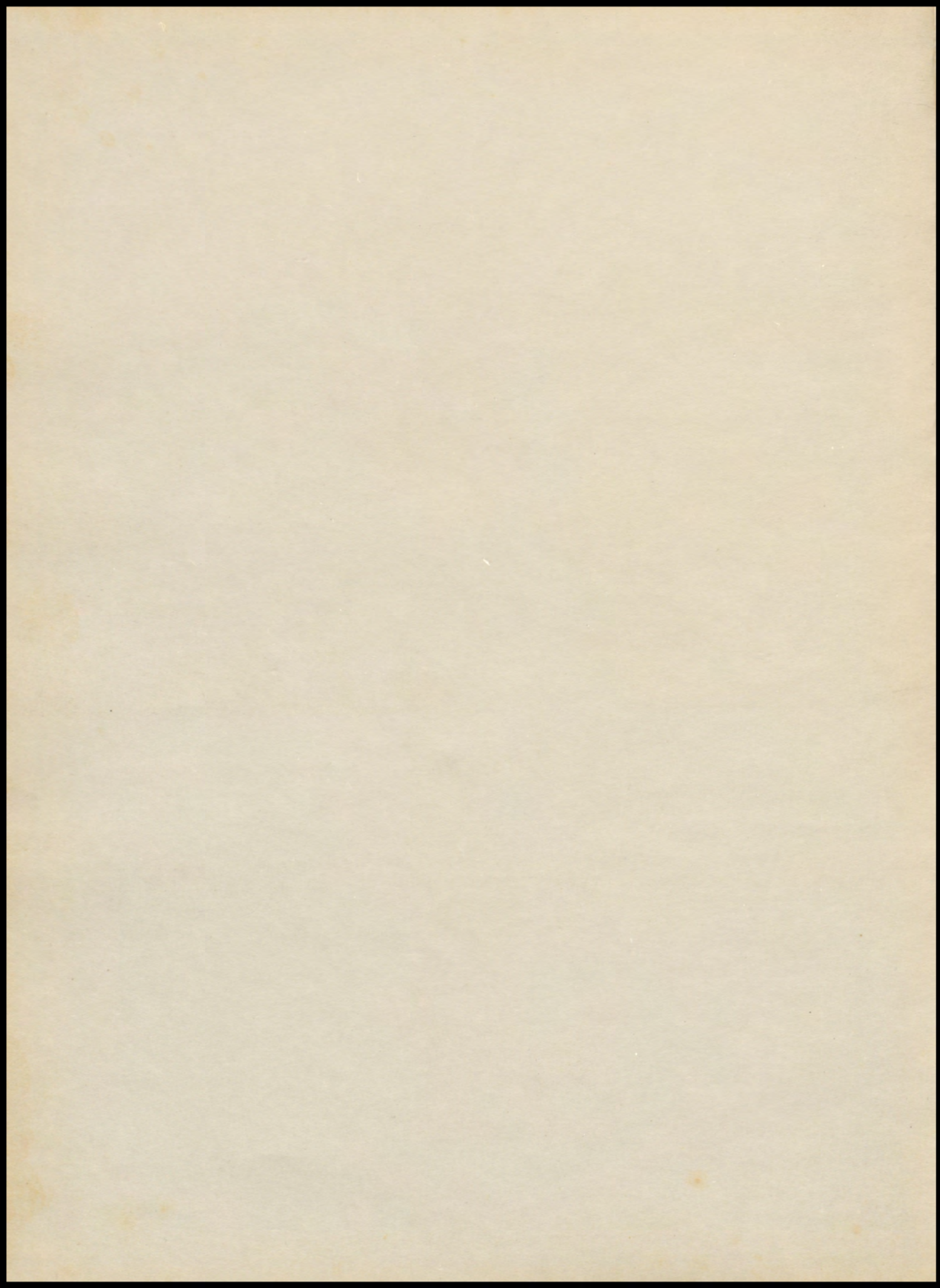

To those of you who will be in Junior High next year, we wish you the best of everything. In later years because of your achievements we will be seeing more of you in future annuals.

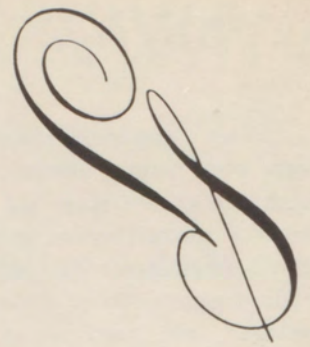
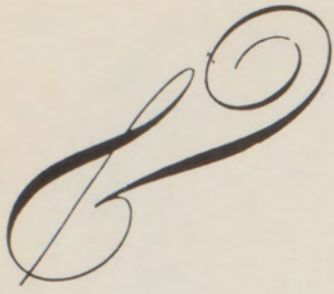

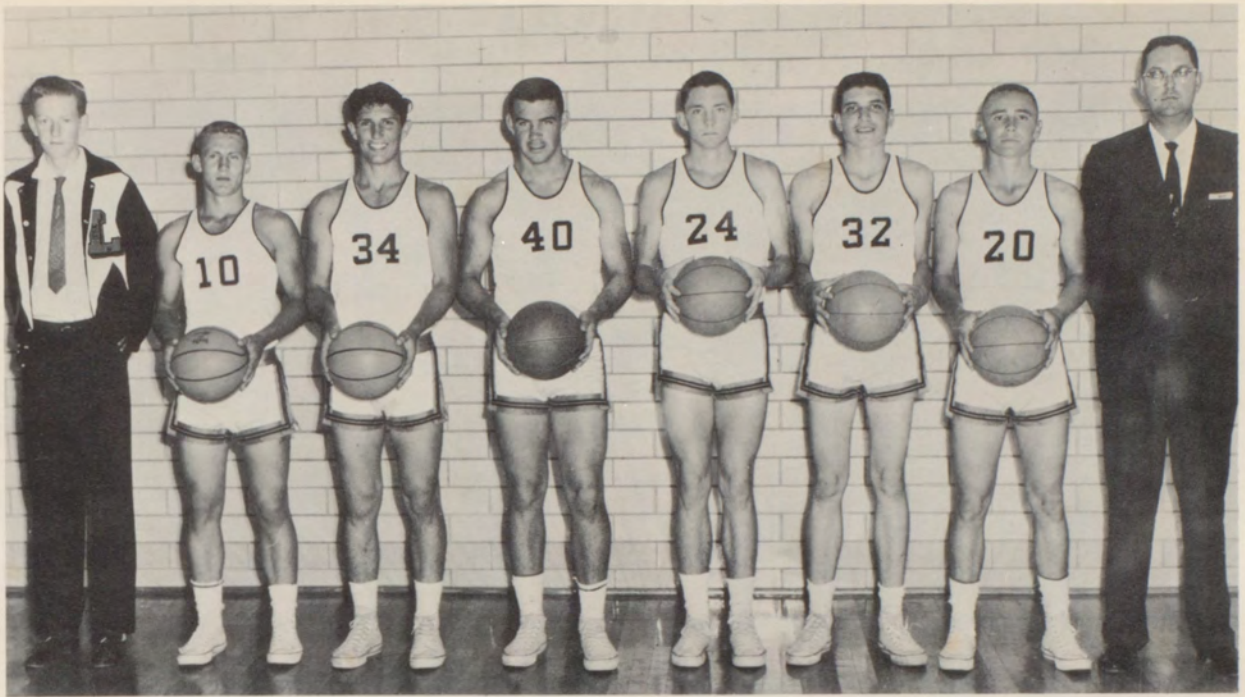

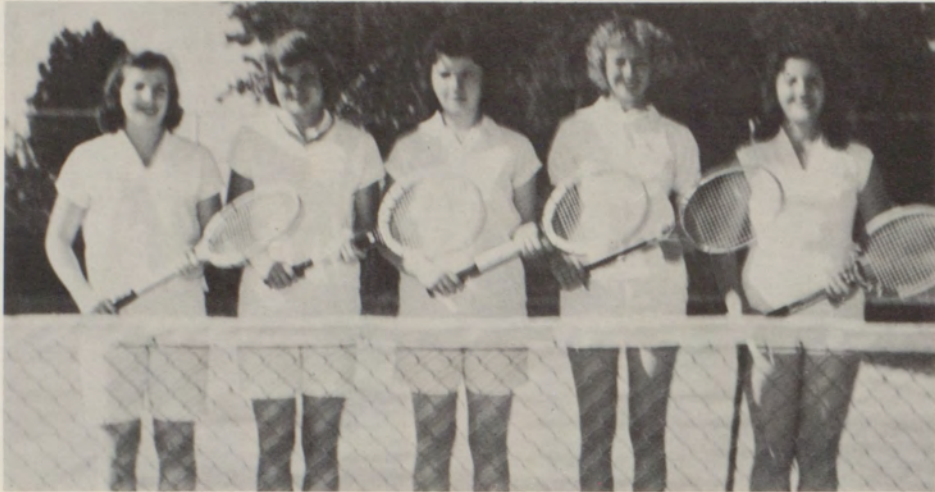

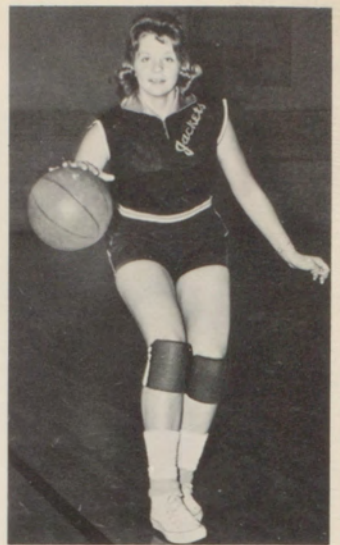
