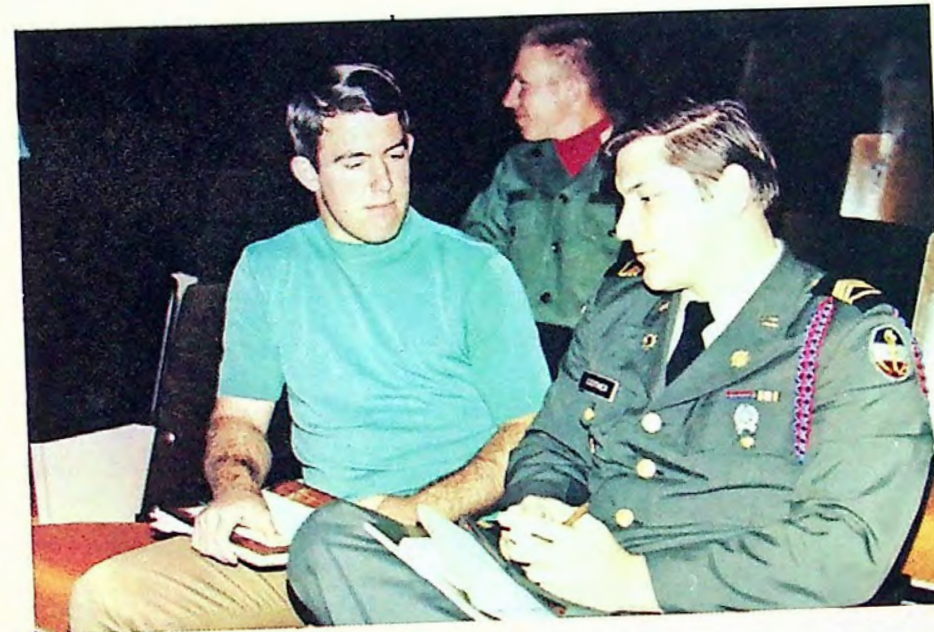
SPONSOR CAREER DAY '72

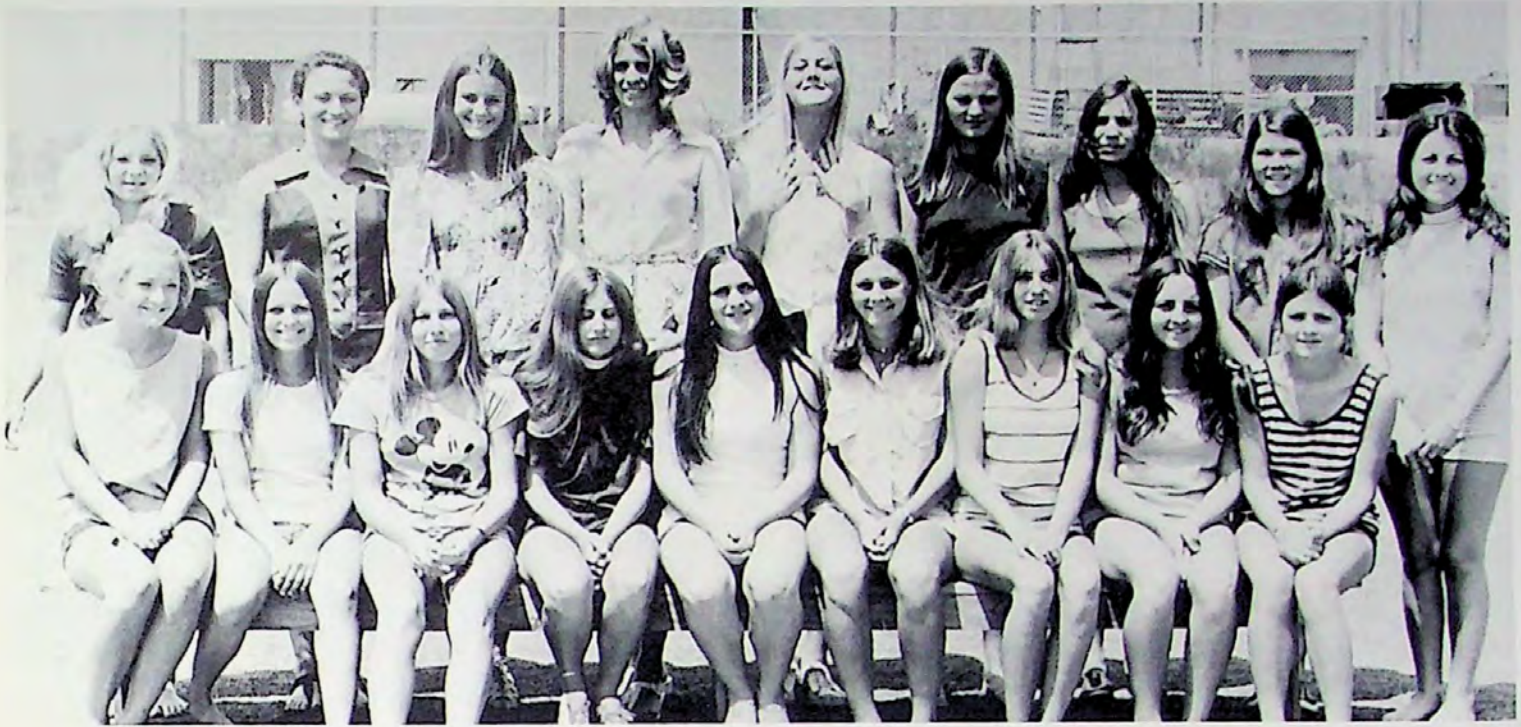

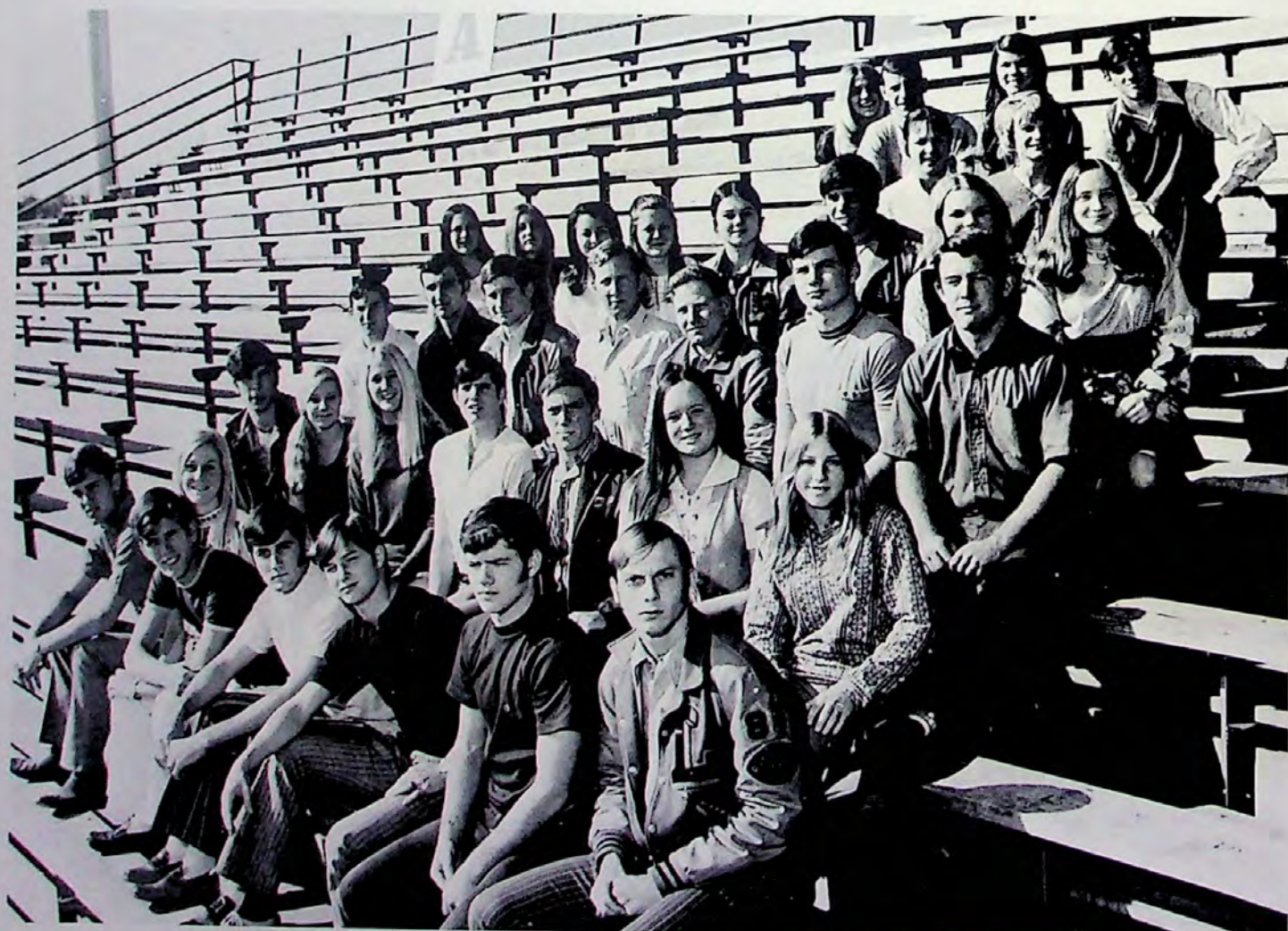
