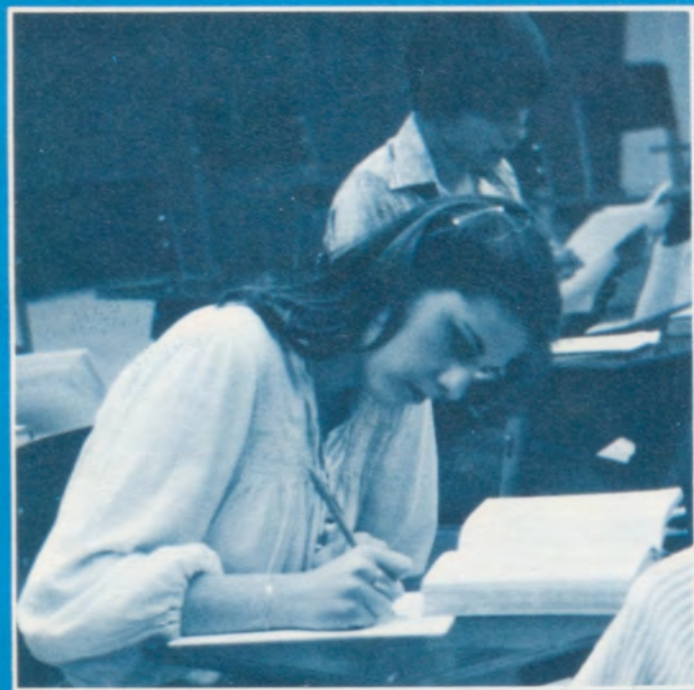

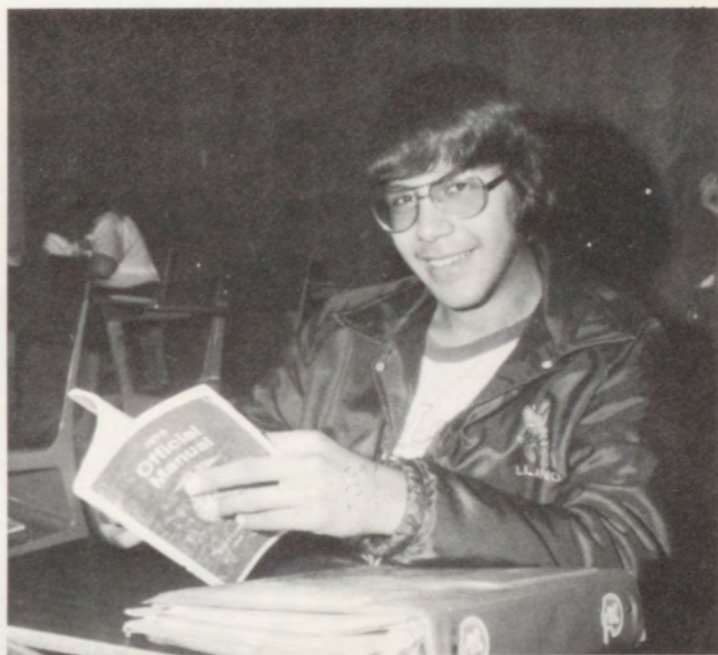

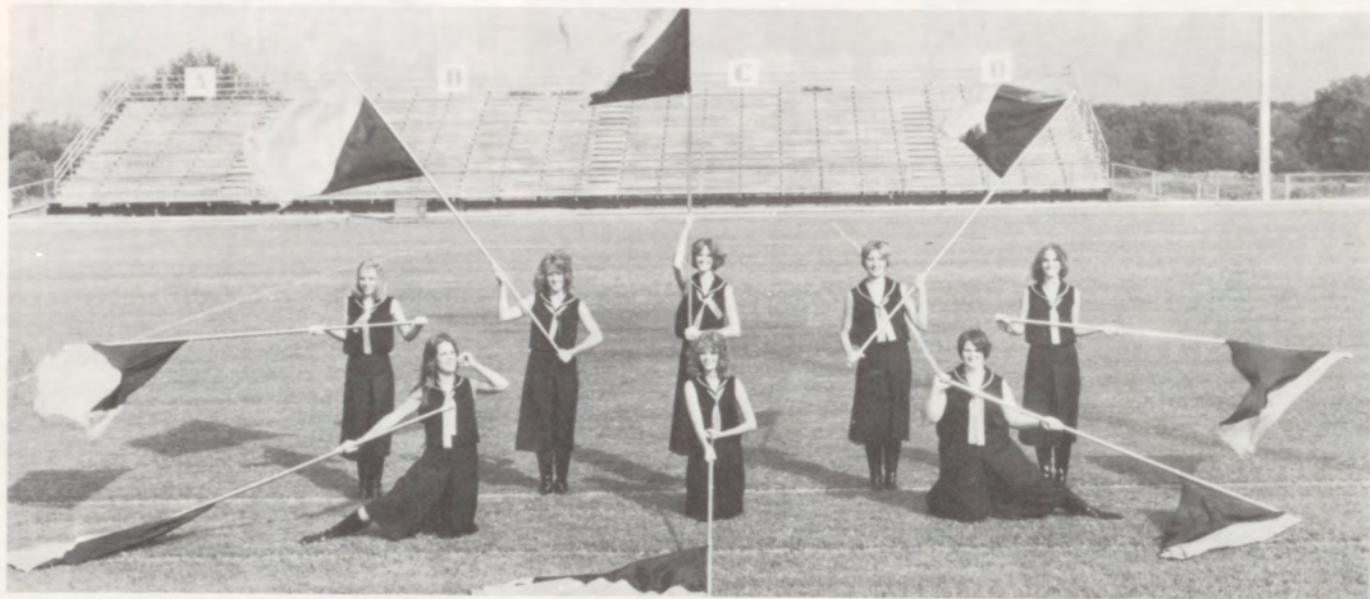
Many members participated in the UIL District, Regional, and area contests. First division ratings were also achieved at the UIL Solo Ensemble contests in Brownwood.
