SCHOOL PROGRESS 1936-1937

WE ARE HIGHLY PLEASED WITH THE PROGRAM THAT HAS RESULTED FROM THE SINCERE EFFORTS WHICH HAVE BEEN EXTENDED THIS YEAR THROUGHOUT EACH DEPARTMENT OF OUR HIGH SCHOOL. WE WANT TO DIRECT OUR THANKS TO EACH TEACHER IN OUR SCHOOL SYSTEM FOR HIS OR HER SINCERE EFFORTS IN PLANNING AND PRESENTING THE WORK AS NEARLY AS POSSIBLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARDS WHICH ARE SO MUCH DESIRED BY OUR STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

ESPECIALLY ARE WE PROUD OF THE PROGRESS MADE IN THE BUILDING UP OF OUR SCHOOL LIBRARY. WE KNOW THAT, AT THE BEGINNING OF THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR, WE HAD ONLY THE SKELETON OF A LIBRARY, CONTAINING, OF COURSE, SEVERAL USEFUL VOLUMES, BUT THESE WERE IN DIRE NEED OF REPAIR. WE HAVE WATCHED WITH INTEREST THE PROGRESS OF SUCH REPAIR WORK, WHICH WAS DONE EXCLUSIVELY BY THE BOYS AND GIRLS OF OUR SCHOOL. WE FEEL THAT SUCH AN ACTIVITY IS MOST WORTHY.

IF OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE TERM "INTEGRATION" IS CORRECT, WE WOULD CALL THIS LIBRARY ACTIVITY AN INTEGRATED UNIT OF WORK, AS THE PROJECT CALLED FOR BUSINESS CORRESPONDENCE, BUSINESS APPOINTMENTS, VISITS FOR PURPOSES OF OBSERVATION AND TRAINING, PLANNING ON KINDS AND AMOUNTS OF MATERIAL NEEDED, CALCULATIONS OF EXPENSES AND PURCHASING OF MATERIALS; AND POSSIBLY THE MOST IMPORTANT WAS THE APPLICATION OF THE KNOWLEDGE GAINED TO THE WORK ITSELF WHICH HAS RESULTED IN THE SKILL AND FUTURE KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH WORK ON THE PART OF EVERY STUDENT WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE PROGRAM.

WE HAVE NOW, INCLUDING THE ORDER THAT HAS BEEN PLACED, APPROXIMATELY ONE THOUSAND USEFUL VOLUMES IN OUR LIBRARY. OUR NEW SELECTIONS, WHICH HAVE BEEN CAREFULLY CHOSEN BY COMPETENT PERSONS, INCLUDE BOOKS FOR THE PRIMARY GRADES AS WELL AS BOOKS TO SUIT THE VARYING READING TASTES OF THE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS. ALL OF OUR BOOKS HAVE BEEN NEATLY AND CAREFULLY ARRANGED ON NEWLY PAINTED SHELVES, AND ARE NOW IN USE BY ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE FOLLOWING A MOTIVATED READING PROGRAM.

NONE THE LESS PROUD ARE WE OF THIS ANNUAL WHICH WAS BEGUN PRIMARILY AS A UNIT IN HIGH SCHOOL ENGLISH, ALTHOUGH THE INTEREST MANIFESTED IN THE WORK HAS EXCEEDED ALL EXPECTATIONS, AS THE ENTIRE STUDENT GROUP HAS EXPRESSED A PERSONAL INTEREST IN THE ACTIVITY. THE WORK, HOWEVER, HAS BEEN CONFINED EXCLUSIVELY TO THE BOYS AND GIRLS OF THE HIGH SCHOOL WITH MINIMUM ADVICE SUPPLIED BY THE LOCAL SPONSORS AND THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PUBLISHER, THE STEOK COMPANY. WE THINK THAT THE BOOK ITSELF WILL SPEAK FOR THE SUCCESS ATTAINED BY OUR STUDENTS. WE WOULD ADD, ALSO, THAT THE FINANCING, WHICH WAS DONE BY THE BOYS AND GIRLS, WAS MOST CLEVERLY WORKED OUT AND THEIR PLANNING RESULTED IN SUCCESSES WHICH WERE HAPPILY SURPRISING TO THEMSELVES.

POSSIBLY OUR MOST ACUTE PROBLEM IN OPERATING THE SCHOOL IN THIS THINLY POPULATED AREA IS THE TRANSPORTATION OF THE CHILDREN TO AND FROM THE SCHOOL CENTER. WE TRANSPORT APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED CHILDREN, BUT SINCE THE MAJORITY OF THESE ARE BELOW HIGH SCHOOL CLASSIFICATION THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WE RECEIVE FROM THE STATE IS INADEQUATE TO COVER THE EXPENSE ON OUR TWO BUSES. THE RESPONSIBILITY OF SUPPLEMENTING THE TRANSPORTATION FUND NATURALLY FALLS ON THE PATRONS OF THE SCHOOL. ABOUT FIFTY PER CENT OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY FUND HAS BEEN SUPPLIED BY STUDENT AUDITORIUM ACTIVITIES. WE COMMEND THESE CHILDREN FOR SUCH TACT AND INITIATIVE AND FOR THEIR SUCCESS IN CARING FOR THIS RESPONSIBILITY WHICH THEY VOLUNTARILY ACCEPTED.

WE EXTEND TO OUR TEACHING STAFF OUR SINCERE THANKS FOR THE PATIENT TIRELESS EFFORT WHICH EACH TEACHER HAS EXPENDED. WE KNOW, OF COURSE, THAT SO MUCH SUCCESSFUL STUDENT ACTIVITY COULD NOT HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE WITHOUT THE ABLE GUIDANCE OF EVERY TEACHER IN THE SYSTEM. WE ARE PROUD OF OUR TEACHERS BECAUSE OF THEIR GENUINELY CO-OPERATIVE SPIRIT IN THE SCHOOL AND THE COMMUNITY, THEIR DESIRE TO GROW PROFESSIONALLY THROUGH THEIR ONE HUNDRED PER CENT EXPECTED ATTENDANCE IN OUR STATE TRAINING INSTITUTIONS THIS SUMMER, AND FOR THEIR HEARTY APPROVAL OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM WHICH IS BEING SO SINCERELY WORKED ON BY OUR STATE SUPERINTENDENT, DR. L. A. WOODS, AND OUR ENTIRE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. WE ARE INDEED PROUD THAT WE COULD WHOLE-HEARTEDLY RE-ELECT EACH TEACHER TO HIS OR HER RESPECTIVE POSITION FOR THE NEXT YEAR.

WE EXPRESS NO AMAZEMENT AT STUDENTS OF THE HUTCHISON SCHOOL FOR THEIR LOVE FOR THEIR INSTITUTION. WE, TOO, ENDORSE MOST HEARTILY THE CHARACTER AND PRINCIPLES FOR WHICH THE SCHOOL STANDS, AND WE FEEL ENCOURAGED IN THE HOPE FOR ITS INEVITABLE GROWTH AND PROSPERITY.

IN CONCLUSION WE SHALL SAY, "CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR BOYS AND GIRLS, TO THEIR TEACHERS, AND TO THE SUCCESSES WHICH HAVE RESULTED FROM THIS YEAR'S WORK."
