#### TO ALL PARENTS

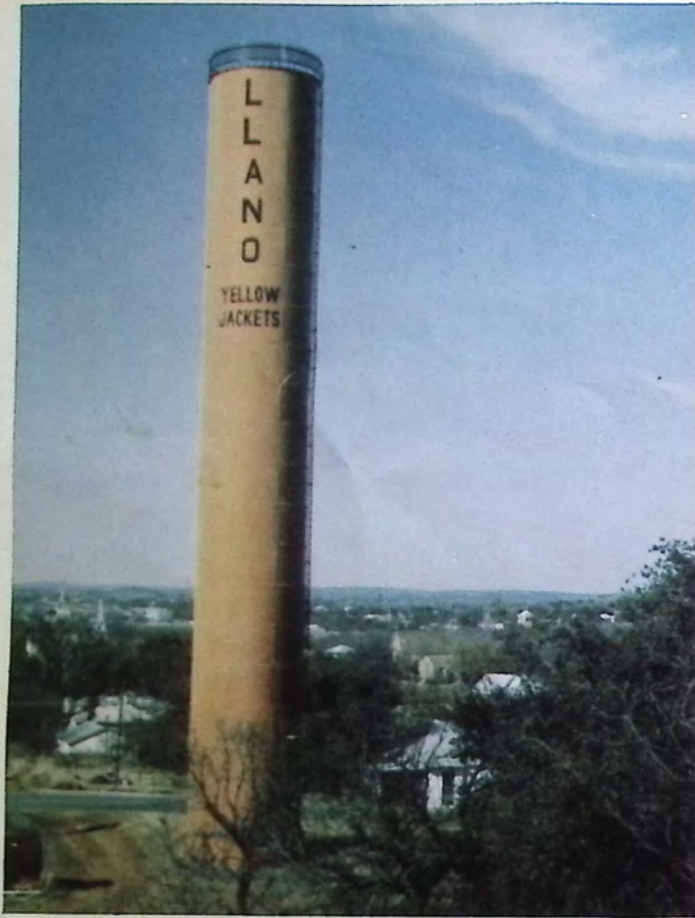

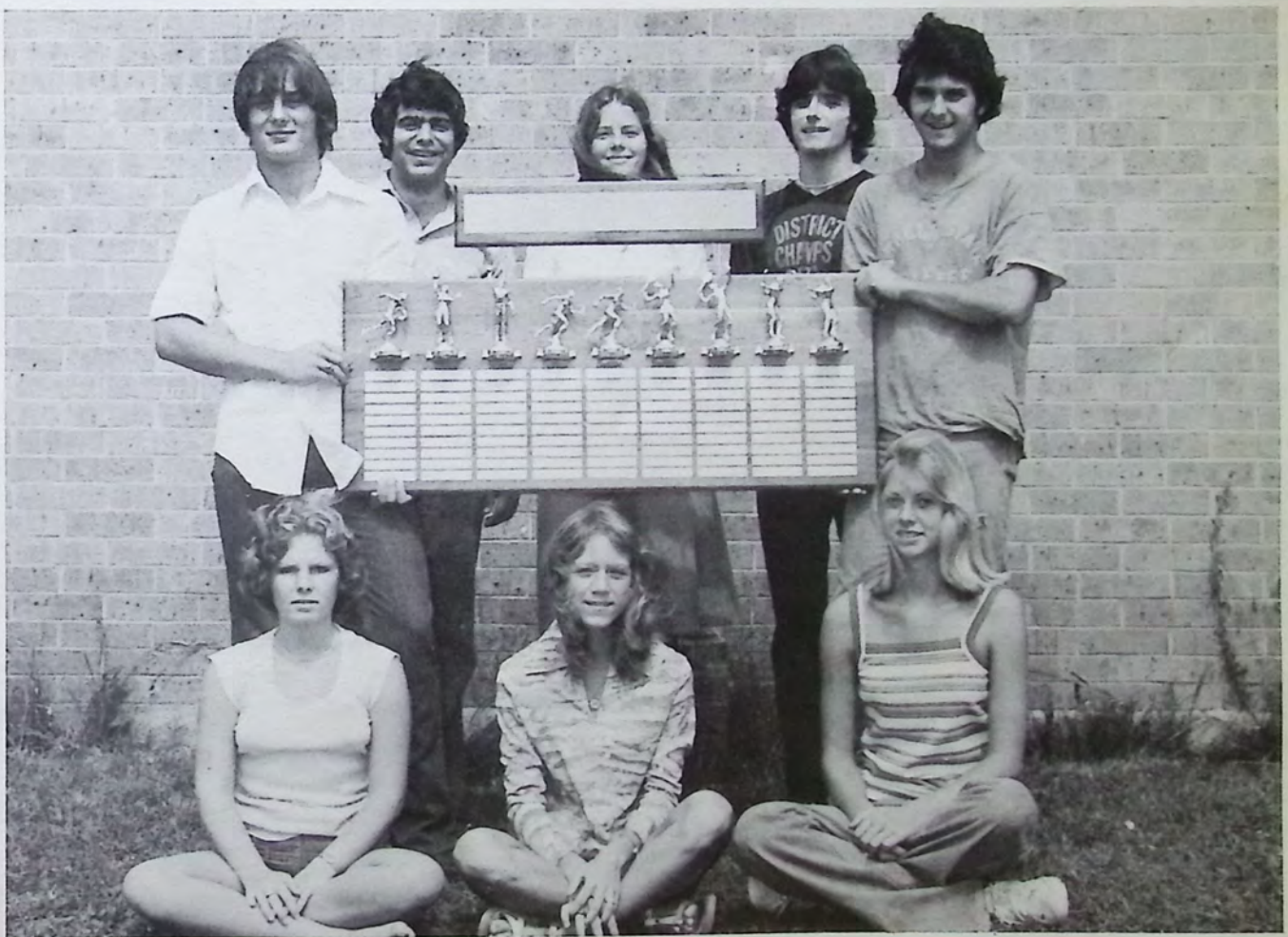


## F.H.A.-F.F.A. Barbecue
