As you look upon the familiar faces on this stage, you may wonder what we have learned from our experiences in school. In the few weeks it took us to grow from careless Kindergarteners to young adults standing on the stage of our graduation we have learned many lessons. There is a certain achievement that is found in having a friend. It is not the kind of accomplishment that you can frame on a wall or put in a trophy case, yet having a friend and being a friend gives a sense of pride that can't be represented by tangible mementos.

Every single one of us here has a friend we will never forget. Friendship is not something taught in the classroom, but learned "the hard way" from relationships with other people. So when you ask what we have learned since that first shy day in Kindergarten, and what skill we think we will use the most in our lives to come, you might be surprised to hear that the answer is "I learned how to make friends."
