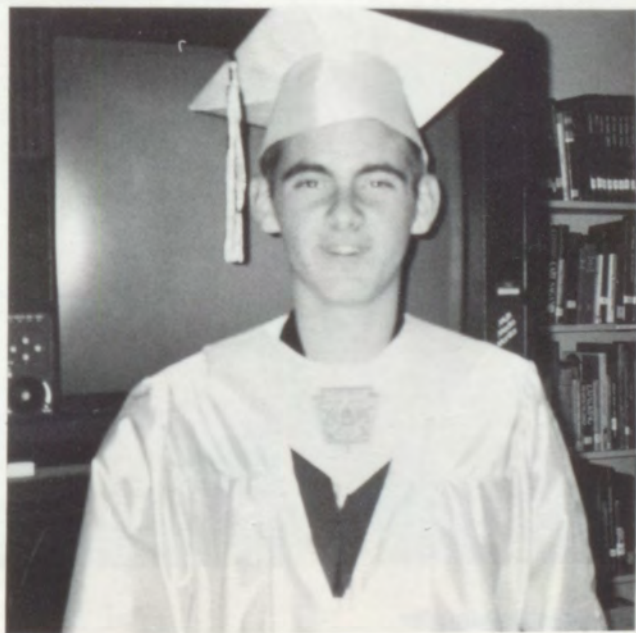


### BEAU WARD--VALEDICTORY ADDRESS

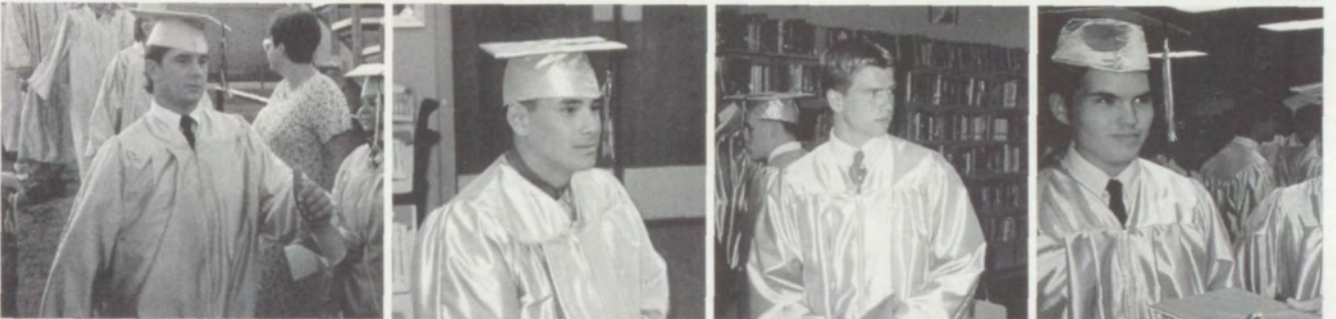
