COMMEMORATIVE CERTIFICATE - BIOGRAPHY OF ANCESTOR

D. Name of Ancestor Isaac Byler Maxwell

Isaac Byler "Ike" Maxwell was born April 21, 1837 in Ripley, Lauderdale County, Tennessee, the son of Isaac D. Maxwell. Ike's mother, Nancy Byler Maxwell, died in 1841. His father remarried leaving Tennessee and settled near Bluffton, Yell County, Arkansas. At the age of 17, on September 8, 1854, Ike crossed the Colorado River settling and naming the land Bluffton, Texas, after his old Arkansas home.

Llano County issued its first marriage license to Ike and Margaret "Maggie" Melcenie Davis. The union produced a daughter, Nancy Ella, and two sons, James Lafayette and William Isaac. Maggie died in 1866. Ike built her coffin and buried her at the Tow Cemetery, Tow, Texas, as the Bluffton Cemetery had not yet opened.

Ike's second wife was Abrigail C. Garrett. She produced nine children. His third wife, Mary Elzire Davis, a niece of his first wife Maggie, had seven children. Ike and Mary also raised three sets of grandchildren.

The young Ike began working cutting firewood for the Salt Works furnaces. He was given land by his first wife's parents. Ike farmed and raised stock on his new land. During child-birthing, he frequently assisted his wife as well as deal with the Indians.

Ike served in the Confederacy as a Pvt. serving under Capt. James S. Bourland's Company, Llano County, 31st Brigade, Texas State Troops. The company was organized for local defense for a period of six months.

Isaac Byler Maxwell was elected to the Texas Legislature (under Governor John Ireland) as a member of the House of Representatives, District #79 and served two years. His term began on January 13, 1885. Ike represented the counties of Runnels, Llano, San Saba, Concho and McCulloch. His duties there consisted of serving on committees for finance, prison, stock-raising and constitutional ammendments. Ike was working in the Legislature during the construction of our present day Capitol and made the suggestion that the Capitol be made of red granite from Burnet County, Texas. He received a commenorative granite square for his efforts and placed a silver coin bearing his name inside the cornerstone of the Capitol.

Ike headed a petition for the first Post Office in Bluffton, Texas.

Ike ran for County Commissioner and Justice of the Peace in 1896. He won the position of Justice of the Peace. He ran again for both County Commissioner and JP in 1898. This time he won both offices for Precinct 2.

Ike was a Church of Christ minister preaching scriptures and comforting families over loss of loved ones. He performed numerous marriages in the area including many close in his immediate families.

Isaac Byler Maxwell was considered to be Llano County's oldest pioneer upon his death, December 15, 1931, becoming one of the first buried at the New Bluffton Cemetery.

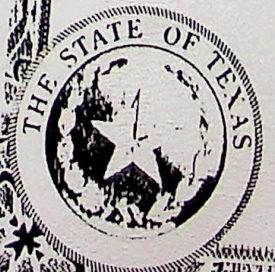

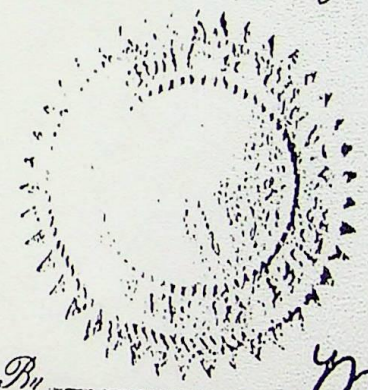

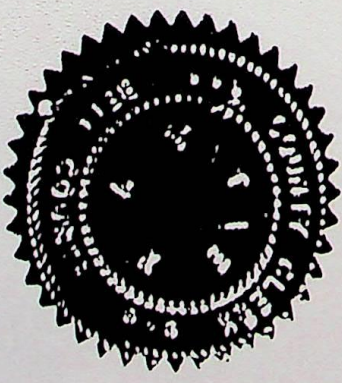

He came to Texas in 1864, and lived two years in Caldwell county, when he removed to Austin where he commenced and pursued with great diligence the study of law, and was admitted to the bar in November, 1867, after examination in the Supreme Court. He was not long after, elected city attorney, then county and afterwards district attorney. He was first elected prosecuting attorney by the commissioners court, second by the people with a majority of 1165, third with 1756 majority, and fourth without opposition, in 1882. He resigned in 1883 and 1884 was elected to the Nineteenth Legislature. Mr. M. is a Democrat, a member of the Methodist Episcopal church, South, and is a Royal Arch Mason, Knights of Honor and Knight Templar. He is a fluent orator, and a man of broad statesmanlike views. He was a member of the following committees: Judiciary No. 2, Constitutional Amendments and Public Debt.

L. B. MAXWELL.

L. B. Maxwell was born April 2, 1831, in Lanadale county, Tennessee, came to Texas in 1854 and settled in Bluffton, Llano county, where he has for the past thirty years engaged in farming, and met with great success. During the civil war he served on the Western frontier. Mr. Maxwell has been Justice of the Peace and County Commissioner of his county prior to his election to the Nineteenth Legislature from the seventy ninth district—Llano, San Saba, McCulloch, Concho, Coleman and Runnels counties. He is a member of the Christian (Campbellite) church, and A. F. and A. M. lodge, and is "an all-wool and-a-yard-wide-impossible-to-curry" Democrat. During the session of the Nineteenth Legislature he served on the following committees: Penitentiary, Finance, Stock and Stock-raising and Constitutional Amendments. Mr. Maxwell made a record as a thinker and legislator that reflects great credit upon him and can not but be pleasing to his constituents.

W. T. MERRIWETHER.

This gentleman, who so ably represented the eighty-first district—Frio, Kinney, Dimmitt, Maverick, Uvalde and Zavala counties—in the Nineteenth Legislature, was born April 16, 1846, in the western district of Tennessee, came to West Texas in 1854, lived a number of years in Guadalupe county and then moved to his present home, Pearsall, Frio county. During the late war he served in Lee's Army of Virginia, and par-

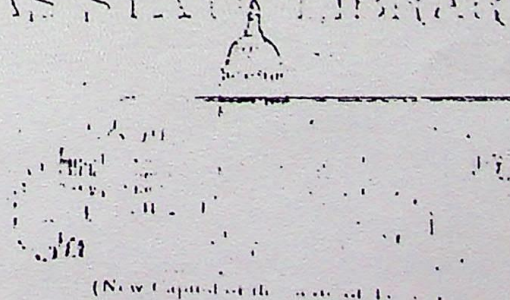

D. Name of Ancestor Isaac Byler Maxwell

Isaac Byler "Ike" Maxwell was born April 21, 1837 in Ripley, Lauderdale County, Tennessee, the son of Isaac D. Maxwell. Ike's mother, Nancy Byler Maxwell, died in 1841. His father remarried leaving Tennessee and settled near Bluffton, Yell County, Arkansas. At the age of 17, on September 8, 1854, Ike crossed the Colorado River settling and naming the land Bluffton, Texas, after his old Arkansas home.

Llano County issued its first marriage license to Ike and Margaret "Maggie" Melcenie Davis. The union produced a daughter, Nancy Ella, and two sons, James Lafayette and William Isaac. Maggie died in 1866. Ike built her coffin and buried her at the Tow Cemetery, Tow, Texas, as the Bluffton Cemetery had not yet opened.

Ike's second wife was Abrigail C. Garrett. She produced nine children. His third wife, Mary Elzire Davis, a niece of his first wife Maggie, had seven children. Ike and Mary also raised three sets of grandchildren.

The young Ike began working cutting firewood for the Salt Works furnaces. He was given land by his first wife's parents. Ike farmed and raised stock on his new land. During child-birthing, he frequently assisted his wife as well as deal with the Indians.

Ike served in the Confederacy as a Pvt. serving under Capt. James S. Bourland's Company, Llano County, 31st Brigade, Texas State Troops. The company was organized for local defense for a period of six months.

Isaac Byler Maxwell was elected to the Texas Legislature (under Governor John Ireland) as a member of the House of Representatives, District #79 and served two years. His term began on January 13, 1885. Ike represented the counties of Runnels, Llano, San Saba, Concho and McCulloch. His duties there consisted of serving on committees for finance, prison, stock-raising and constitutional ammendments. Ike was working in the Legislature during the construction of our present day Capitol and made the suggestion that the Capitol be made of red granite from Burnet County, Texas. He received a commenorative granite square for his efforts and placed a silver coin bearing his name inside the cornerstone of the Capitol.

Ike headed a petition for the first Post Office in Bluffton, Texas.

Ike ran for County Commissioner and Justice of the Peace in 1896. He won the position of Justice of the Peace. He ran again for both County Commissioner and JP in 1898. This time he won both offices for Precinct 2.

Ike was a Church of Christ minister preaching scriptures and comforting families over loss of loved ones. He performed numerous marriages in the area including many close in his immediate families.

Isaac Byler Maxwell was considered to be Llano County's oldest pioneer upon his death, December 15, 1931, becoming one of the first buried at the New Bluffton Cemetery.

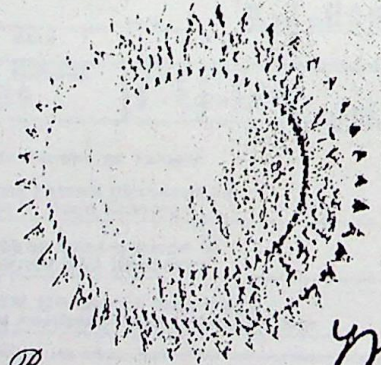

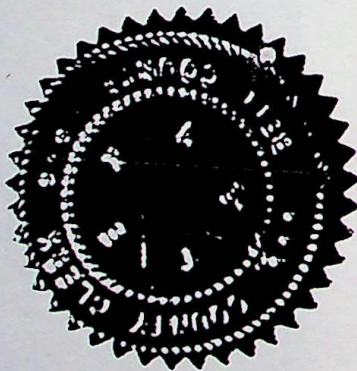

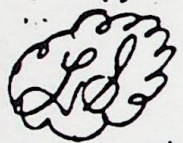

He came to Texas in 1864, and lived two years in Caldwell county, when he removed to Austin where he commenced and pursued with great diligence the study of law, and was admitted to the bar in November, 1867, after examination in the Supreme Court. He resigned in 1883 and 1884 was elected to the Nineteenth Legislature. Mr. M. is a Democrat, a member of the Methodist Episcopal church, South, and is a Royal Arch Mason, Knights of Honor and Knight Templar. He is a fluent orator, and a man of broad statesmanlike views. He was a member of the following committees: Judiciary No. 2, Constitutional Amendments and Public Debt.

I. B. Maxwell was born April 2, 1831, in Lanadale county, Tennessee, came to Texas in 1854 and settled in Bluffton, Llano county, where he has for the past thirty years engaged in farming, and met with great success. During the civil war he served on the Western frontier. Mr. Maxwell has been Justice of the Peace and County Commissioner of his county prior to his election to the Nineteenth Legislature from the seventy ninth district—Llano, San Saba, McCulloch, Concho, Coleman and Runnels counties. He is a member of the Christian (Campbellite) church, and A. P. and A. M. lodge, and is "an all-wool and a yard-wide-impossible-to-curry" Democrat. During the session of the Nineteenth Legislature he served on the following committees: Penitentiary, Finance, Stock and Stock-raising and Constitutional Amendments. Mr. Maxwell made a record as a thinker and legislator that reflects great credit upon him and can not but be pleasing to his constituents.

W. T. MERRIWETHER.

This gentleman, who so ably represented the eighty-first district—Frio, Kinney, Dimmitt, Maverick, Uvalda and Zavala counties—in the Nineteenth Legislature, was born April 16, 1846, in the western district of Tennessee, came to West Texas in 1854, lived a number of years in Guadalupe county and then moved to his present home, Pearsall, Frio county. During the late war he served in Lee's Army of Virginia, and par-

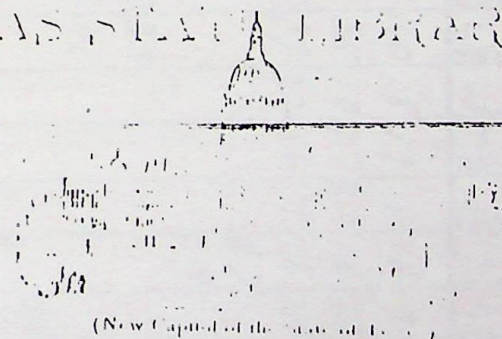
