COMMEMORATIVE CERTIFICATE - BIOGRAPHY OF ANCESTOR

D. Name of Ancestor MARTIN WILLIAM NOLEN

Martin William Nolen was born in Kingsland, Texas on 16 May 1882. the son of Allen Nolen and his wife Mary Elizabeth Carter. Martin had four brothers all older than him. In 1888 when Martin was six years old, his father died. The next year his mother died, leaving the five boys orphaned. The Probate Court appointed a guardian to care for the children and property. The property being 245 acres of land just North of Kingsland. Over the years until the children came of age, a number of guardians were appointed. The story goes that Martin was not treated well by one of the guardians and ran away. This same story says that he lived with his older brother Peter after Peter came of age in 1891. Martin would have been nine years at that time. It appears that Peter and Martin worked as farm hands around Kingsland for number of years. Some where in there Peter became ill and eventually had to be put in a State Home. Records were not good in those days and it is hard to tell just when this all happened. It seems that Peter had epilepsy and in those days they did not know what to do about it so the person was put in a State Institution. He died in the State Home in Abilene in 1923.

Martin met Rhoda Katherine Petty and married her in 1905 when he was 23 years old. They had their first of five children 1906. All but the last two being born in Kingsland.

The Llano County deed records show that Martin Nolen purchased land from a Mrs. H.A. Hill in 1914. This land included a house and cotton gin. A part of the purchase contract was that Martin Nolen operate the gin during each and every ginning season until the balance of purchase money shall have been paid. (copy from deed book attached). Martin Nolen and his family later moved to Burnet. In later years he lived on a farm just out of Johnson City, Tx. Where he died in 1945.

County of Llano) KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS : That I, Mrs. M.A.Hill, formerly Mrs. M.A.Edwards, an unmarried woman, of the County of Llano, State of Texas, for and in consideration of the of Twenty Five Hundred and no/100 Dollars, to me paid and secured to be paid as follows: Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars, cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged; the balance of Twenty Three Hundred and no /100 Dollars, to be paid as follows, that is to say; That said deferred payment is to be paid according to the following terms and conditions:

- First- The said M.W.Nolen shall keep the gin and dwelling situated on land, in reasonably good repair and condition, usual wear and tear excepted.
- Second- That he shall operate and run said gin during each and every ginning season until said balance of purchase money above mentioned shall have been paid according to the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned.
- Third- That he shall pay interest on the said deferred payment at the rate of eight percent per annum from date hereof; said interest payable annually on December 1st of each year.
- Fourth- That he shall pay to the said Mrs. M.A.Hill, in liquidation of said debt each year the sum of two dollars and no/100 (\$2.00) for each bale of cotton ginned by him, the said M.W.Nolen, the same to be paid semi-monthly during the ginning season; said payments to be first applied to the payment of all interest due thereon and the balance to be applied to the credit of said principal indebtedness.

Fifth- That he shall keep said dwelling and gin insured in some good reliable Old Line Insurance Company for amount not less than Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,800) and pay his proportionate part of taxes and insurance from date of deed.

Name of Ancestor

ALLEN NOLAN

Allen Nolen was born in Blount County, Tennessee on 15 Mar 1815. The son of Joseph Nolen and his wife Rebecca(Nolen). Not too much is known about the time spent in Tennessee, but land records show that Joseph had property on Nine Mile Creek near Maryville, Tennessee. Allen had 12 brothers and sisters and most, if not all, were born in Blount County, Tennessee.

The 1840 and 1850 census showed the Joseph Nolen family to be in Benton (now Calhoun) Co., Alabama. However, the 1850 census did not mention Allen Nolen. He was more than likely in Georgia because his third child, daughter Sarah, was born in Georgia on 27 Nov 1851. Allen married Margaret Jane (Nolen) in either Alabama or Georgia. No record of the marriage has been found. Their first child, Thomas Lee Nolen, was born 8 Oct 1847 in Alabama. The second child, Margaret Adaline Nolen, was born in 1848 in Alabama. The third child, Sarah, was born in Georgia, and the next two children were born in Texas. Joseph Nolen II on 13 July 1855 and Jacob A. Nolen in 1857.

The Texas General Land Office has on file a record of Allen Nolen claiming a homestead of 320 acres in Rusk County, Texas. The record is dated 15 Oct 1853. The land is located 20 and 1/2 miles South of the town of Henderson, Texas. It was in East Texas in 1870 that Allen's first wife died. This was spelled out in the Probate Court papers of Allen and his second wife in Llano County when they died. Allen in 1888 and his wife Mary Elizabeth Carter in 1889. They had 245 acres in Llano County just North of Kingsland.

The exact date of Allen's arrival in Llano County is not known. The title to the land he owned is not on record in the courthouse. The courthouse burned in 1880 and they have very little record prior to that time. The best guess is before 1875. He had four children by his second wife and they were all born in Kingsland. The first child, Peter G. Nolen, was born in Feb 1873. The death certificate for Peter says he was 53 years old when he died on 23 Jun 1923. That would mean he was born in 1870. Since no birth record is available, it is a guess. The second child, Robert Monroe Nolen, was born 1 Aug 1875 in Kingsland. The third child, John Clayton Nolen, was born in 1877 in Kingsland. The fourth child, Jack Ross Nolen, was born 6 Dec 1879 in Kingsland, and the last child was Martin William Nolen...born 16 May 1882 in Kingsland. Martin William Nolen was my grandfather. All of the children were minors when the parents died. A guardian was appointed by the Probate Court (Cause #189, Estate of Allen and Elizabeth Nolen) to take care of the children and property.

Allen and his wife Mary Elizabeth are buried on the property they owned just North of Kingsland. The graves are between the two small mountains that you see on the right side of Highway 1431 just as you leave Kingsland North bound. The property was later sold to a Mr. Long and then to a Mr. Hickey. The present owner is the David Scott family.

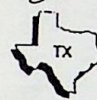
